2009 ANNUAL REPORT SUMMARY

The Kiel Police Department's 2009 Annual Report has recently been submitted to the Kiel City Council for their review. This report is considered "public record" and anyone interested in reading the report can do so at the police department during regular business hours (Mon-Fri). Copies of the report can also be purchased for \$5.00. If you would like to purchase a copy of the report, please contact Chief Funkhouser directly.

Our annual report contains information related to the Kiel Police Department's (KPD) operations in 2009 including information about the department's staff, equipment, public relations, and community outreach programs, but also statistical data with charts, graphs, and summaries regarding the police department's activity for 2009 but also comparative statistical data from previous years.

The following is a brief summary of some of the statistical data contained within the report;

CALLS FOR SERVICE / INCIDENTS

- Our police department handled 1,977 calls for service / reported incidents in 2009
- This represents an 11% decrease in calls for service from 2008 but is still above our 6 year average
- For the 6 year period of 2004 2009: K.P.D. handles an average of 1,826 per year

ARRESTS

- K.P.D. made <u>394 arrests</u> in 2009 which represent an overall increase of 5.5% from 2008's total
- The total number of arrests averages out to an average of over 46 arrests per officer per year
- Those arrests resulted in the referral to court on 474 counts. (A single arrest can have multiple "counts")
- Drug related arrests increased by 70% in 2009 including several felony cases
- Peace & Order offense related arrests increased by 17% with "Disorderly Conduct" being the most common offense

CITATIONS AND WARNINGS

- KPD issued 810 citations and 867 written warnings in 2009. This is an increase in overall enforcement of 5%
 - Average speeding citation was for motorists driving <u>17 mph</u> over the posted speed limit. (16mph in 2008)
 - Average reported BAC for a driver arrested for Operating While Intoxicated was 0.19 (Legal limit is .08)
 - Our OWI arrests increased by 28% in the City of Kiel in 2009 over last year's OWI arrests
 - Over 52% of our contacts (traffic or otherwise) result in the offender receiving a written warning in lieu of a citation. This clearly shows a pattern of fair and balanced enforcement while still achieving compliance.
 - o Reducing accidents and increasing safety is our main goal in conducting traffic enforcement

MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENTS:

- In 2009 our police department investigated a total of **91 motor vehicle accidents** (Down 22% from 2008)
 - o This is the 4th straight year that motor vehicle accidents have decreased in our community
 - Since '06 motor vehicle accidents reported in the City of Kiel have decreased by an avg of 10% per year

MISCELLANEOUS DATA

- In 2009, K.P.D. officers logged over 76,000 miles on patrol which is an average of over 60 miles per shift
- Our officers average about 30 minutes per shift on foot patrol and logged over 40 hours of bike patrol in 2009
- In terms of % of calls / incidents reported in 2009: Thursdays and Tuesdays are the busiest for K.P.D.
